

Travel Study to San Juan & Vieques, Puerto Rico

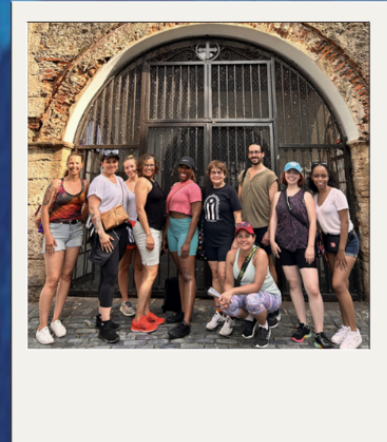
Experience Puerto Rico!
